1. Background

The Improving Health and Nutrition Conditions through Systematic and Evidence-Based Solutions for Marginalized Communities (IHNCSESMC) project aims to improve health and nutrition outcomes among marginalized communities by integrating IEC/BCC materials into ongoing community education and awareness activities. These materials will be disseminated through existing project channels such as community meetings, health workshops, and local government offices to ensure the broad reach and reinforcement of key health messages.

2. Objective

To develop high-quality, culturally appropriate, and evidence-based Behavior Change Communication (BCC) / Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials aligned with national guidelines and project goals to promote healthy behaviors among beneficiaries in Banishanta union parishad of Dacope Upazila in Khulna District of Bangladesh.

3. Scope of Work

3.2 Material Development

The consultant/agency will design the following BCC/IEC materials across multiple key thematic areas. Materials must be audience-friendly, culturally appropriate, language-sensitive (Bangla), and visually engaging, especially for low-literacy community members.

- Materials must be print-ready, compatible with local printing capacities.
- Adherence to DALIT's branding guidelines and project visibility requirements.
- BCC/IEC Materials must be developed using Bangla Unicode fonts.
- Soft copies of each designed material will be handed over to DALIT in .ai and .jpeg formats.

- Familiarity with national health policies and behavior change frameworks.
- Demonstrated capacity in graphic design, illustration, and desktop publishing.
- Prior work with NGOs, INGOs, or public health projects preferred.

- Portfolio of similar past work.

- Cost breakdown for:
 - Content development
 - Design and illustration
 - Pretesting coordination
- All costs must be inclusive of taxes, revisions, and administrative fees.
- Quoted in Bangladeshi Taka (BDT).
